Councilmember Luna wanted to acknowledge the hard work of the Mesa Fire and Medical dispatchers and the Falcon Field Airport controllers regarding an incident over the past weekend.

Fire Chief Mary Cameli explained that the incident was an Alert 2 which means an airplane is having trouble landing. She noted the pilot was having trouble with the landing gear and had lost contact with the towers. She stated the pilot had contacted his wife, who called 9-1-1 to communicate the situation. She said there had been three dispatchers working this incident, and the pilot was able to land safely with the help and communication of everyone involved.

Mayor Giles expressed his condolences on the passing of John Whiteman who was active within the Mesa community, helping establish the Arizona Museum for Youth, now known as the i.d.e.a. Museum, sponsored early-childhood learning and programs within Mesa Public Schools, and sat on the board for the Mesa Chamber of Commerce.
