

RESOLUTION NO. 10195

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MESA AND THE TOWN OF FLORENCE FOR THE SHARING OF RADIO COMMUNICATIONS SITES AND FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for the establishment of modern and reliable radio communications systems with the Town of Florence; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement would allow the City of Mesa and the Town of Florence to install infrastructure at one or more of each other's sites that would augment the coverage of Mesa's and Florence's communications systems.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Mesa and the Town of Florence to enter into a radio communications site sharing is hereby authorized.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to execute the Agreement, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the person who signs the agreement thereon. The City Manager or designee is further authorized to approve minor, administrative, technical, or procedural changes to the terms of the agreement as needed and the City Clerk may attest that signature.
