

RESOLUTION NO. 10264

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE CITY OF MESA FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MESA TECHNOLOGY ACCELERATOR.**

**WHEREAS**, the City is authorized by A.R.S. §11-952 to enter into Intergovernmental Agreements; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Mesa, in partnership with Arizona State University, seeks to establish the Mesa Technology Accelerator to support entrepreneurialism, create jobs, and encourage new investment in Mesa and the surrounding region; and

**WHEREAS**, The Council has determined that the establishment of the Mesa Technology Accelerator is in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Intergovernmental Agreement for the establishment of the Mesa Technology Accelerator located on the Arizona State University Polytechnic campus, between Arizona State University and the City of Mesa is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement ("Agreement") on behalf of the City of Mesa, together with all other documents necessary to carry out the provisions of such agreement, and the City Clerk, DeeAnn Mickelsen, or her designated representative is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon. The City Manager, or his designated representative, is further authorized to approve minor, administrative, technical, procedural and non-material modifications to the Agreement, and all of its exhibits, as needed.
