

RESOLUTION NO. 9874

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN VALLEY METRO RAIL, INC. AND THE CITY OF MESA FOR THE CENTRAL MESA LIGHT RAIL EXTENSION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Valley Metro Rail Inc. (METRO) is a nonprofit, public corporation charged with the design, construction, and operation of the Phoenix metropolitan area's light rail transit system;

WHEREAS, METRO and the City of Mesa desire to extend the existing light rail system in the City of Mesa with the Central Mesa Light Rail Transit Extension Project, which consists of approximately 3.1 miles of double light rail track and associated improvements extending the current light rail lines to a new end of line station on Main Street between Mesa Drive and Lesueur;

WHEREAS, the City of Mesa and METRO desire to enter into a Design and Construction Agreement to govern the parties responsibilities for the engineering, procurement, construction, and funding for the Central Mesa Light Rail Transit Extension Project.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to execute the Design and Construction Agreement on behalf of the City of Mesa for the Central Mesa Light Rail Transit Extension Project, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the

signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon.

Section 2: That the various City officers and employees be and hereby are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
