

RESOLUTION NO. 9902

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION BY THE CITY OF GLENDALE, ARIZONA TO BE THE HOST FOR SUPERBOWL XLIX.

WHEREAS, The National Football League (“League”) owns, produces and controls the annual professional football championship game known as the “Super Bowl” and NFL Properties LLC (“NFLP” or together with the League, the “NFL”) owns produces and controls the “NFL experience,” and along with other NFL Affiliates owns, produces and controls certain other events associated with the Super Bowl (“Official Events”); and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesa supports the application of the City of Glendale, Arizona to host Superbowl XLIX; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesa recognizes the goodwill, prestige and worldwide renown garnered by the State of Arizona and all municipalities located within Maricopa County, Arizona from the international coverage and recognition associated with Super Bowl and related events; and

WHEREAS, the NFL has requested a declaration of support for Glendale’s bid for Superbowl XLIX and Official Events from the City of Mesa;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Mesa hereby supports the selection of the City of Glendale, Arizona as the host for Superbowl XLIX and supports the selection of Glendale, Arizona or any other Maricopa County city or town to host any and all Official Events related to Superbowl XLIX.

Section 2. That the City of Mesa looks forward to supporting the City of Glendale in providing for necessary and reasonable governmental services in connection with the Super Bowl and related Official Events.
