Joe Guinn, 126 West 7th Place, related difficulties encountered by his business which is located near the intersection of Mesa Drive and Broadway Road and by children walking to a nearby elementary school. Mr. Guinn stated that a large number of individuals congregate on the street corners in search of employment and asked that Council consider erecting signage such as "No Loitering".

Mayor Brown informed Mr. Guinn that staff is working on improving the situation near his business and thanked him for his patience.

Bill Brando, 61 South Macdonald, expressed the opinion that a door equipped with a bolt lock requiring a key to open would assist in protecting small children from the hazards associated with a pool. Mr. Brando suggested that Council consider requiring that a bolt lock be installed on doors that exit into the backyards of residences that contain a pool.
