### Action Items

- a. Discussion of the creation and implementation of methods to educate the community about stereotypes, facts and myths related to immigrants.
  1. Discuss the Utah Compact, opportunities for exploration and education efforts for the Human Relations Advisory Board.
2. Discuss and provide direction on Goal No 3 of the HRAB's 2010/11 Strategic Plan which recommends direction for City Council to insure that Mesa's diverse populations have equal access to and equal treatment in receiving city services.

### Action Items

- a. Continue discussion and creation of hate crime and nondiscrimination ordinances for the city of Mesa.
  - i. Create opportunities for continued exploration and education efforts related to potential anti-harassment, non-discrimination ordinances for: 1) the Human Relations Advisory Board, 2) the community, 3) the Mesa City Council.
    1. Identify and provide direction on best practices for implementation.
      - a. Recommend timeline, plan events, and objectives, including:
        - i. Organize a Forum on hate crimes, anti-harassment and non-discrimination ordinances for the March 23 Human Relations Advisory Board meeting.
          1. If granted approval from proper channels, film Forum events for later distribution.
        - ii. Organize a day-long public Diversity Forum, to be held Saturday, March 26.
        - iii. Participate in Community Cinema monthly film series to be organized by the Diversity Office.
      2. Identify potential allies and target audience.
3. Items from citizens present.
