Introductions, Recognitions, and Announcements Board Chair Pamela Rineholt recognized Library Director Heather Wolf as she spoke to the Board about the upcoming Citizen Advocate Day (CAD) in Washington, DC, May 2017. Ms. Wolf had also provided the Board with CAD information and the application process in a separate email.

# Dobson Ranch Library update

Branch Coordinator Sarah Prosory welcomed the Board to the Dobson Ranch Library and provided both background information and an overview of the library's remodel project.

## Background:

- Dobson Ranch Library (DRL) opened in June 1987 and information for its 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary will be forthcoming.
- Vice Mayor Kavanaugh funded an outside Butterfly Garden (BG) in early 2015 in front of and behind the library.
- LED landscape lighting have been added to the library's pathways courtesy of Vice Mayor Kavanaugh and the Parks department.
- The DRL monument sign has been refurbished to include LED lighting and the library's new logo.

### Remodel:

- A patron 2012 survey identified patron wants: a bathroom inside the library, study rooms, noise reduction in the children's room and updated environment appearance.
- Worked with EMC2 to create a master plan for the DRL layout.
- The remodel started in 2013; funded over a 3-year period, \$100,000/year
- Remodel completed in three phases:
  - o Phase I: inside bathroom and staff area reconfigured
  - Phase II: study rooms and noise reduction wall in children's room installed
  - Phase III: main floor area reconfigured, new furniture added throughout the building, shelf height modified and new acrylic end panels added to the shelf ends.
