Vice Mayor Davidson excused Mayor Hawker from the beginning of the meeting.

1. Review items on the agenda for the October 11, 2000 Special Council Meeting.

All of the items on the agenda were reviewed among Council and staff with no formal action taken.

2. Hear reports on meetings and/or conferences attended.

Mayor Hawker reported on his recent attendance at a meeting with Ivan Makil, President of the Salt River Indian Community, in which a variety of topics were discussed including freeway construction, dust abatement and the location of a rock crusher plant. Mayor Hawker stated that he has also participated in several meetings at the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT).

Councilmember Jaffa explained that he and Vice Mayor Davidson attended the Friends of the Tonto National Forest Committee meeting and advised that the Committee discussed the establishment of national recreational areas along the boundaries of the National Forest which would prevent the Federal government from conducting land swaps.

Councilmember Whalen stated that he participated in the annual "rail-volution" convention in Denver, Colorado, which focused on national and international transit issues.

Mayor Hawker announced his attendance at the first meeting of the Mesa 2025 Shared Vision Committee and outlined the Committee's long-term goals.
