1. Prescheduled public opinion appearances. (Maximum of three speakers for five minutes per speaker.

- a. Hear from Tom Stincic regarding "Land use planning and the Mesa General Plan!".

Mr. Stincic informed the Council that a large number of Lehi residents were opposed to the granting of approval for construction of the AT&T Wireless PCS, Inc. cellular service on the DeWitt Property. Mr. Stincic expressed the opinion that the City of Mesa's General Plan should be adhered to and stressed the importance of retaining the atmosphere of rural communities such as Lehi. Mr. Stincic added that future issues of a similar nature should be addressed earlier and indicated his intent to forward additional information to the Council relative to this matter for their future use. Mr. Stincic expressed appreciation to the Council for allowing him an opportunity to present his views.

Mayor Wong thanked Mr. Stincic for his comments.

- b. Hear from Kirby Allan regarding "Our freedom killing political systems are destroying our country and the great American dream."

Mr. Allan spoke in opposition to current City administration and expressed the opinion that the media reports relative to candidates and the upcoming election are incorrect and misleading.

Mayor Wong thanked Mr. Allan for his comments.

2. Items from citizens present. (Maximum of three speakers for five minutes per speaker).

Krishna Harracasingh, 1711 East 1st Street, complimented Mayor Wong on his years of service to the City of Mesa. Mr. Harracasingh expressed concern relative to negative election campaigning methods and encouraged all candidates to conduct themselves professionally and treat all citizens of the City in a fair and equitable manner.

Mayor Wong thanked Mr. Harracasingh for his input.
