Approved on March 19, 2014 – to support the on-street parking restrictions stated in the covenants, conditions and restrictions of The Commons Industrial Park at Falconview (east of Val Vista Drive and north of McDowell Road, Council District 5).

Approved on April 7, 2014 – modification of an existing parking prohibition to maintain clear travel lanes and proper traffic signal operation on 6th Street (east and west of Country Club Drive, north of University Drive, Council District 1).

- On the north side from a point 202 feet west of North Country Club Drive to a point 215 feet east of North Country Club Drive
- On the south side from a point 226 feet west of North Country Club Drive to a point 172 feet east of North Country Club Drive

Approved on April 16, 2014 – from 10:00 pm to Sunrise in all parks operated and maintained by the City of Mesa to allow Park Rangers to issue citations for overnight parking (Citywide).

Approved on April 24, 2014 – to maintain clear travel lanes and proper traffic signal operation on Riverview Auto Drive (west of Dobson Road, north of Rio Salado Parkway, Council District 1).
