

ORDINANCE NO. 5024

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING "REVISION TO TITLE X OF MESA CITY CODE—JANUARY 2011" BY REFERENCE**

WHEREAS, the current process to modify traffic regulations is inconsistent and can take up to four months to implement; and

WHEREAS, a more expedited process for implementing traffic regulations is possible and would be consistent with other cities in the metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Director and the Transportation Advisory Board recommend that most traffic regulation decisions be delegated by the Council to the City Traffic Engineer to improve City responsiveness to citizen and staff identified traffic concerns;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That certain document known as "Revision to Title X of Mesa City Code—January 2011" which document was made a public record by Resolutions No. 9802 of the City of Mesa, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

Section 2: SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance is held to be unenforceable or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall remain in effect.

Section 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. The effective date of this ordinance shall be 30 days following adoption by the Mesa City Council.
