

ORDINANCE NO. 5306

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, ARIZONA AMENDING SECTION 10-3-13 OF THE MESA CITY CODE PERTAINING TO TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF MESA; AND PROVIDING CIVIL SANCTIONS FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 10-3-13 (E) 4. of the Mesa City Code, hereafter mentioned in its entirety, is amended to include flashing yellow arrows as a Traffic-Control Signal Legend:


10-4-3 (E) 4. Green, Yellow, and Red Arrows.

- (a) Green Arrow. Vehicular traffic facing a green arrow signal, shown alone or in combination with another indication, may cautiously enter the intersection only to make the movement indicated by such arrow or such other movement as is permitted by other indications shown at the same time. Such vehicular traffic shall yield the right-of-way to pedestrians lawfully within an adjacent crosswalk and to other traffic lawfully using the intersection.
- (b) Yellow Arrow. Vehicular traffic facing the signal is thereby warned that the related green arrow movement is being terminated or that a red indication will be exhibited immediately thereafter when vehicular traffic may not enter the intersection.
- (c) Red Arrow. Vehicular traffic facing a steady red arrow signal shall stop at a clearly marked stop line, but if none, before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, or if none, then before entering the intersection, and will remain standing until an indication to proceed is shown.
- (d) **Flashing Yellow Arrow. Vehicular traffic facing a flashing yellow arrow signal, shown alone or in combination with another indication, may cautiously enter the intersection only to make the movement indicated by such arrow or such other movement as is permitted by other indications shown at the same time. Such vehicular traffic shall yield the right-of-way to pedestrians lawfully within an adjacent crosswalk and to other traffic lawfully using the intersection.**

Section 2: Civil Traffic Violations: Any violation of or failure or refusal to do or perform any act required by the provisions of this ordinance or of the Mesa City Code as amended herein shall constitute a civil traffic violation.
