

ORDINANCE NO. 191

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESA FIXING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE REGULATIONS, CONDITIONS AND TERMS OF THE CITY OF MESA GAS CODE AS ADOPTED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA IN RESOLUTION NO. 646A, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Mesa, County of Maricopa, State of Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. That it be and is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to install, alter or repair, or to cause to be installed, altered or repaired, any gas appliance or house gas piping, to turn on or re-connect, or to cause to be turned on or re-connected, any gas service, to remove or disconnect, or to cause to be removed or disconnected, any gas appliance, in the City of Mesa, contrary to or in violation of any of the provisions of the City of Mesa Gas Code, as adopted by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Mesa in Resolution No. 646A.

Section 2. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of said City of Mesa Gas Code, or who causes, permits, or suffers such to be done, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during which any violation of any of the provisions of said Code is committed, continued or permitted, and upon conviction of any such violation shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$250.00, or by imprisonment for not more than 50 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. That the issuance or granting of a permit under the provisions of said Code shall not be deemed or construed to be a permit for, or an approval of, any violation of the provisions of said Code. No permit presuming to give authority to violate or cancel any of the provisions of said Code shall be valid, except insofar as the work which is authorized is lawful.

Section 4. Inspection and approval of work done in violation of said City of Mesa Gas Code shall not be construed as relieving the

person, firm or corporation having done such work of his or their responsibility.

Section 5. The Plumbing Inspector of the City of Mesa and his deputies shall perform such duties as are specifically set forth and described in said City of Mesa Gas Code, together with such other duties as may from time to time be directed by the Common Council.

Section 6. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances, all resolutions and parts of resolutions, all motions and parts of motions, and all other adoptive action on the part of the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Mesa in conflict with this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed.



That this ordinance is urgently required for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Mesa, and it is necessary that this ordinance shall immediately become effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Mesa.
