

RESOLUTION NO. 10124

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE, TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND ENTITLEMENT FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE UNDER THE DODD-FRANK WALL STREET REFORM AND CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT OF 2010.

WHEREAS, the proposed activities to be undertaken have been advertised and hearings have been held concerning the Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3, in order to inform Mesa citizens and to receive comments regarding projects to be undertaken by the City with the Entitlement Funds available for this program under the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010 ("Act").

WHEREAS, the Mesa City Council has been provided with recommendations of City department activities to be funded under the provisions of the Act and has approved all activities and funding allocations; and

WHEREAS, a Proposed Statement of the projected use of funds has been completed in accordance with federal requirements and made available to the public; and

WHEREAS, the proposed activities to be undertaken by the City departments meet the objectives and priorities as identified in the City's Consolidated Plan and Substantial Amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager or his designated representative is hereby authorized to accept and expend Entitlement Funds available to the City of Mesa under the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010 for activities as approved by the City Council.

Section 2: The City Manager or his designated representative is authorized to amend and sign any amended applications without the further consent of the City Council, provided all said amendments or revisions are required by those agencies charged with the responsibility of reviewing said applications under the Acts.
