

RESOLUTION NO. 10196

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MESA AND THE APACHE JUNCTION FIRE DISTRICT, AND THE TOWN OF QUEEN CREEK FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA).

WHEREAS, The authority for the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant is derived from the Federal Fire Prevention and Control Act of 1974 (15 U.S.C. §§ 2229 et seq.), as amended; and

WHEREAS, Congress appropriated a total of \$285,625,000 for the FY 2012 to the Assistance to Firefighters Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesa Fire and Medical Department partnered with the Apache Junction Fire District and the Town of Queen Creek Fire Department, and applied for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Mesa Fire and Medical Department, Apache Junction Fire District, and Town of Queen Creek Fire Department's application requested funds for fire ground survival training and related equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesa Fire and Medical Department, Apache Junction Fire District, and Town of Queen Creek Fire Department were awarded \$416,600 with a 20% cost match requirement; and

WHEREAS, the federal contribution is \$333,280, and the City of Mesa Fire and Medical Department, the Apache Junction Fire District, and the Town of Queen Creek Fire Department match contribution combined is \$83,320; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesa Fire and Medical Department agreed to serve as the host applicant and assume the responsibility for accountability of the assets and all reporting requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Apache Junction Fire District and Town of Queen Creek Fire Department in good faith agreed to pay for their percentage of grant required cost match for the aforementioned training and equipment including all applicable taxes; and

WHEREAS, it is agreed the funds provided through the Fiscal Year 2012 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program will be used for fire ground survival training and related equipment outlined in the grant application unless the City of Mesa requests an amendment requiring FEMA's approval; and

WHEREAS, the Grant's period of performance ends February 08th, 2014 unless the City of Mesa requests an amendment to extend the period, which requires FEMA's approval,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving an intergovernmental agreement between the City of Mesa Fire and Medical Department and the Apache Junction Fire District for the 2012 Assistance to Firefighters Grant.

Section 2: Approving an intergovernmental agreement between the City of Mesa Fire and Medical Department and the Town of Queen Creek Fire Department for the 2012 Assistance to Firefighters Grant.

Section 3: Approving an intergovernmental agreement between the City of Mesa Fire and Medical Department and FEMA to accept the Assistance to Firefighters Prevention and Safety Grant award.

Section 4: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to attest to and execute the agreement, and any amendments thereto, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager thereon.
