RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA MODIFYING WASTEWATER TERMS, RATES, FEES AND CHARGES FOR CITY-OWNED UTILITY SERVICES AND DECLARING THIS RESOLUTION AND ATTACHED SCHEDULES TO BE PUBLIC RECORDS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, COUNTY OF MARICOPA, STATE OF ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: THAT THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULES AND TITLES WITH RESPECT TO TERMS, RATES, FEES AND CHARGES FOR CERTAIN UTILITY SERVICES, TRUE AND CORRECT COPIES OF WHICH ARE ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE PART HEREOF AND INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE, ARE HEREBY ESTABLISHED OR AMENDED AND ADOPTED TO BE APPLICABLE FOR THE BILLING OF UTILITIES FOR THE BILLING CYCLES ENDED ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 27, 2013.

MULTI-UNIT DWELLING WASTEWATER SERVICE INSIDE THE CITY WITH ON-SITE
WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY ABANDONMENT

APPLICATION

These rates are applicable to all multiple dwelling units within the City limits not having a water meter for each dwelling unit (includes trailers, or mobile homes) where such customer has abandoned an on-site wastewater treatment facility within the last year and signed an agreement regarding connection to the municipal wastewater collection system, and agrees to make a nonrefundable contribution in aid of construction equal to the cost of any necessary extension (not otherwise provided by customer), allocated system costs, required system improvements, and other applicable fees, costs, and charges for the billing of utilities for the billing cycles ended on or after November 27, 2013 for service provided on and subsequent to the date on which those same billing cycles started.

MONTHLY BILLING CYCLE (Based on water consumption)

The charge per billing cycle shall consist of the following components:

Service Charge: *\$14.80

Usage Charge: \$1.29 per 1,000 gallons for water delivered **

Plus: \$2.34 per 1,000 gallons for water delivered** in excess of 5,000 gallons

*2,000 gallons of water included as a minimum based on availability of service.

**Based on 95 percent of a customer's metered water deliveries per billing cycle.

ADJUSTMENTS

Taxes & Impositions. The applicable proportionate part of any taxes or governmental impositions that are assessed on the basis of the gross revenues of the City and/or the price or revenue from the energy or services Taxes & Impositions. The applicable proportionate part of any taxes or governmental impositions that are assessed on the basis of the gross revenues of the City and/or the price or revenue from the energy or services sold hereunder shall be added to each utility bill.

A System Connection Cost Adjustment Factor ("SYSCCAF") shall be added to all bills based on payment within one year of the unpaid amounts (not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00)) of the contribution in aid of construction, allocated system costs, required system improvements, and other applicable fees, costs, and charges as shown on the agreement.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

See Terms and Conditions for the Sale of Utilities.

Extension of the City's wastewater collection system, in all circumstances, is subject to the availability of adequate capacity at the beginning point of any extension. The City will not undertake the initiation of wastewater service to new areas which are within its existing area of service but which are separated from its existing collection facilities by any substantial distance without due consideration of the health and safety issues presented, the City's ability to meet its obligations to existing customers, and consideration of such other factors as may be approved in the circumstances.

All construction, including that for which customers have made contributions, will be owned, operated, and maintained by the City.

MULTI-UNIT DWELLING WASTEWATER SERVICE OUTSIDE THE CITY WITH ON-SITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY ABANDONMENT

APPLICATION

These rates are applicable to all multiple dwelling units outside the City limits not having a water meter for each dwelling unit (includes trailers, or mobile homes) where such customer has abandoned an on-site wastewater treatment facility within the last year and signed an agreement regarding connection to the municipal wastewater collection system, and agrees to make a nonrefundable contribution in aid of construction equal to the cost of any necessary extension (not otherwise provided by customer), allocated system costs, required system improvements, and other applicable fees, costs, and charges for the billing of utilities for the billing cycles ended on or after November 27, 2013 for service provided on and subsequent to the date on which those same billing cycles started.

MONTHLY BILLING CYCLE (Based on water consumption)

The charge per billing cycle shall consist of the following components:

Service Charge: *\$21.94

Usage Charge: \$1.29 per 1,000 gallons for water delivered **

Plus: \$4.10 per 1,000 gallons for water delivered** in excess of 5,000 gallons

*2,000 gallons of water included as a minimum based on availability of service.

**Based on 95 percent of a customer's metered water deliveries per billing cycle.

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
