

RESOLUTION NO. 10337

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE TO ENTER IN TO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE SALT RIVER PIMA-MARICOPA INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR THE RECEIPT AND DISTRIBUTION OF PROPOSITION 202 FUNDS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Arizona's Indian Gaming Compact provides that a Tribe makes twelve percent (12%) of its net annual State contribution to cities, towns or counties for government services that benefit the general public.

Section 2: The Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community wishes to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Mesa to receive and distribute \$435,000 from its 2013 12% revenues for grants as follows:

\$ 15,000.00 to the **Arizona Town Hall** for community outreach programs.

\$160,000.00 to the **City of Mesa** for the Mesa Fire and Immunization program, Rainwater Harvesting program, the Guerrero Rotary Park revitalization project and the Mesa Grande education project.

\$ 20,000.00 to the **Girl Scouts of Arizona Cactus Pine Council** to assist with funding for the Campaign for Girls & Women in Arizona to rebuild Camp Sombrero.

\$50,000.00 to the **Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation** to provide Scholarships to children of Marines and Navy Corpsmen, with special attention to children of Marines who have been killed or wounded.

\$ 40,000.00 to **Tumbleweed Center for Youth Development** for Project Safe Place & Open Hands Shelter.

\$150,000.00 to the **United Food Bank** for the funding of Emergency & Supplemental Food program.

Section 3: The City Council supports these grants and authorizes the City Manager to enter into the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement with the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community for the receipt and distribution of this funding.
