

RESOLUTION NO. 10363

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE STREET NAME CHANGE FROM 3RD PLACE TO MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. WAY FROM NORTH CENTER STREET TO NORTH CENTENNIAL WAY.

WHEREAS, based on a proposal from the Mesa Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration Committee and subsequent meetings with the Committee and the Transportation Advisory Board and public outreach, the City Council hereby supports the street name change of 3rd Place from North Center Street to North Centennial Way to Martin Luther King, Jr. Way; and

WHEREAS, the City Council amended its policy regarding changing street names in Resolution 10116 adopted on August 27, 2012 and that policy was followed, and this street name change meets the policy's criteria by recognizing the historic significance of the neighborhood and Martin Luther King, Jr.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, as follows:

Section 1: That the Mesa City Council hereby approves the street name change from 3rd Place to Martin Luther King, Jr. Way, from North Center Street to North Centennial Way.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution; and the City Clerk, DeeAnn Mickelsen, or her designated representative is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative on such documents.
