

RESOLUTION NO. 10425

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE TO ACCEPT FEDERAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$62,500 TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S TRAFFIC SECTION TO ENHANCE THE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF MESA. THESE FUNDS ARE MADE AVAILABLE FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY THROUGH A HIGHWAY SAFETY CONTRACT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Accepting federal funding for traffic equipment through Highway Safety Contract with the Governor's Office of Highway Safety, and any related amendments or supplements thereto.

Section 2: Authorizing and directing the City Manager, or his designated representative, to accept federal funding for traffic equipment from a Highway Safety Contract with the Governor's Office of Highway Safety to enhance the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program throughout the City of Mesa, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City of Mesa, and authorizing the City Clerk to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his designated representative thereon.
