

RESOLUTION NO. 10510

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MARICOPA COUNTY AND THE CITY OF MESA FOR EXCHANGE OF SERVICES RELATED TO THE ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY VOLUNTEER PROGRAM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving the Intergovernmental Agreement between Maricopa County and the City of Mesa which establishes procedures to authorize the County Transportation Director (or designee) and the City's designee to enter into binding letters of agreement (LOA) for specific roadway segments where right-of-way is owned by both Maricopa County and the City. The LOAs establish processes and facilitate volunteer cleaning activities in such specific roadway segments.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to enter into the agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City of Mesa, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon.

Section 3: That the various City officers and employees be and hereby are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
