

**RESOLUTION NO. 10552**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A SUBGRANTEE AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO ACCEPT \$216,000 FOR EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S RAPID RESPONSE TASK FORCE.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Accepting \$216,000 in funds from the Arizona Department of Homeland Security for equipment and training for the Police Department's Rapid Response Task Force.

Section 2: Authorizing and directing the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into a Subgrantee Agreement with the Arizona Department of Homeland Security and any related amendments or supplements thereto, to accept \$216,000 in funds for equipment and training, on behalf of the City of Mesa, and authorizing the City Clerk to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his designee thereon.
