

RESOLUTION NO. 10715

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PUBLIC HIGHWAY AT-GRADE CROSSING IMPROVEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY AND THE CITY OF MESA FOR RAILROAD SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT DOBSON ROAD (APPROXIMATELY 650 FEET SOUTH OF 1ST AVENUE).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving the Public Highway At-Grade Crossing Improvement Agreement between the Union Pacific Railroad Company and the City of Mesa which identifies and defines the responsibilities of the Railroad and City for their respective roles in the installation of gates and signals for railroad safety at Dobson Road (approximately 650 feet south of 1st Avenue) and any related amendments or supplements thereto.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to enter into the agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City of Mesa, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon.

Section 3: That the various City officers and employees be and hereby are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
