

RESOLUTION NO. 10724

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RECOGNIZING THE SERVICE OF CHARLES K. LUSTER TO THE COMMUNITY AND RENAMING THE UTILITIES BUILDING LOCATED AT 640 NORTH MESA DRIVE, MESA, ARIZONA, IN HIS NAME.

WHEREAS, Charles K. Luster is a native of Arizona who has devoted his life to serving our country and the City of Mesa.

WHEREAS, Mr. Luster served our country by joining the United States Navy in 1943 and continued to serve after World War II in the Navy Reserves for over thirty years.

WHEREAS, Mr. Luster attained a degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Arizona, and in 1957 he began his career at the City of Mesa as the City Engineer.

WHEREAS, Mr. Luster's service to the City of Mesa included being the Public Works Director, Assistant City Manager, and the City Manager. When Mr. Luster retired from the City in 2000, he had been the City Manager for twenty-one years and had served the City of Mesa for nearly forty-three years.

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds it appropriate to honor Mr. Luster's service and dedication to the City of Mesa, and to celebrate his 90th birthday, by renaming the Utilities Building to the Charles K. Luster Building, and by holding a dedication ceremony for the renaming on December 10, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, as follows:

Section 1. That the Utilities Building located at 640 North Mesa Drive, Mesa, Arizona, is hereby renamed to the:

Charles K. Luster Building
