

RESOLUTION NO. 10737

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF MESA FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE RIO SALADO MULTIUSE PATH FROM SR101L TO DOBSON ROAD.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) and the City of Mesa identifies the responsibilities of ADOT and the City concerning the maintenance of the Rio Salado Multiuse Path from SR101L to Dobson Road. The specific location of the Rio Salado Multiuse Path is depicted on Exhibit A hereto.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City of Mesa, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon.

Section 3: That the various City officers and employees be and hereby are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
