

RESOLUTION NO. 10772

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT OF MARICOPA COUNTY AND THE CITY OF MESA FOR PURCHASE, INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF AUTOMATED WARNING STATIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Flood Control District of Maricopa County and the City of Mesa which for the purchase, installation and maintenance of automated warning stations relating to detection of severe thunderstorms and a more detailed understanding of rainfall/runoff relationships in Mesa watersheds.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to enter into the agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City of Mesa, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon.

Section 3: That the various City officers and employees be and hereby are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
