

RESOLUTION NO. 9644

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE CITY OF MESA HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

Whereas, Maricopa County has historically experienced severe damage from natural and human-caused hazards such as flooding, wildfire, drought, severe weather, and hazardous materials incidents resulting in loss of property and life, economic hardship and threats to public health and safety;

Whereas, the City of Mesa Hazard Mitigation Plan (the Plan) has been developed after more than one year of research and work by the City of Mesa in association and cooperation with the Maricopa Hazard Mitigation Planning Group for the reduction of hazard risk to the community;

Whereas, the Plan specifically addresses hazard mitigation actions/projects that will provide mitigation for specific natural and human caused hazards that impact the City of Mesa with the effect of protecting people and property from loss associated with those hazards;

Whereas, a public meeting was held to present the Plan for comment and review as required by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

The City of Mesa Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby approved and adopted.
