

RESOLUTION NO. 9665

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, REQUESTING THE FEDERAL OFFICE OF ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT RECOGNIZE THE CITY OF MESA AS THE LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR THE DISPOSITION OF THE AIR FORCE RESEARCH LABORATORY.

WHEREAS, the Department of Defense has declared the Air Force Research Laboratory located at 6030 South Kent Street in Mesa to be surplus as prescribed under the Base Realignment and Closure Act (BRAC); and

WHEREAS, BRAC procedures require that planning for the future reuse and redevelopment of surplus military properties be conducted by a Local Redevelopment Authority (LRA), which must include the local agency responsible for land use planning; and

WHEREAS, the reuse or redevelopment of the parcel of land and associated buildings is expected to be of interest to multiple parties, organizations or individuals for various purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the community's best interest that the City conduct a thorough outreach and planning process consistent with BRAC requirements in order to determine a preferred plan for the reuse and redevelopment of the Air Force Research Laboratory property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

THE City Council hereby requests that the Office of Economic Adjustment recognize the City of Mesa as the LRA for the Air Force Research Laboratory property.
