

RESOLUTION NO. 9764

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE SALT RIVER PIMA-MARICOPA INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF GAMING PROCEEDS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Arizona's Indian Gaming Compact provides that a Tribe make twelve percent (12%) of its net annual State contribution to cities, towns or counties for government services that benefit the general public.


Section 2: Through the City of Mesa, the Mesa Fire Department, Mesa Public Schools, Arizona Junior Achievement and the East Valley United Food Bank are receiving distributions from the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community.

Section 3: The Mesa City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community for the receipt and distribution of grants as follows:

- \$50,000 – Mesa Fire Department for their Immunization Program
- \$15,000 – Junior Achievement Business & Economic School Programs
- \$78,000 – Mesa Public Schools-Native American Education Program
- \$175,000 – United Food Bank Food Supply
