RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA MODIFYING WASTEWATER TERMS, RATES, FEES AND CHARGES FOR CITY-OWNED UTILITY SERVICES AND DECLARING THIS RESOLUTION AND ATTACHED SCHEDULES TO BE A PUBLIC RECORD

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, COUNTY OF MARICOPA, STATE OF ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:



RESIDENTIAL WASTEWATER SERVICE INSIDE THE CITY

APPLICATION

These rates are applicable to all dwelling units within the City limits having an individual water meter measuring combined domestic and landscape use and where a usable wastewater main adjoins the premises for the billing of utilities for the billing cycles ended on or after ~~August 30, 2010~~ **August 30, 2011** for usage occurring on and subsequent to the date on which those same billing cycles started. This rate also applies to customers with City of Mesa wastewater utility service but not City of Mesa water utility service.

The charge per billing cycle shall consist of the following components:

	\$2.66 2.81 (user charge billing component)
<u>Plus:</u>	\$1.19 1.26 per 1,000 gallons of average winter water consumption** (user charge component)
<u>Plus:</u>	\$2.16 2.29 per 1,000 gallons of average winter water consumption** in excess of 5,000 gallons (capital related component)

Customers who do not have an individual average winter water consumption established shall be assessed a flat monthly charge based on the most recent citywide residential class average winter water consumption.

***Includes 2,000 gallons of water as a minimum charge for capacity availability.**

**Average winter water consumption shall be based upon the water usage listed on the utility bills during the past December, January, February, and March billing cycles. The average will be computed at the end of March each year on the three lowest readings of this four-month period. Additionally, customers shall be billed based on the assumption that only 90 percent of their average winter water consumption is discharged to the wastewater system.
