

RESOLUTION NO. 9961

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF RECLAMATION FOR WATERSMART WATER AND ENERGY EFFICIENCY FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the United States Bureau of Reclamation provides grant funding for local government and non-profit projects that will conserve energy or enhance efficiency in public water management; and,

WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department wishes to make application for funding from the United States Bureau of Reclamation's WaterSMART Grant Program on behalf of the City; and,

WHEREAS, Applicants for such WaterSMART Grant Program funding are required to provide a resolution adopted by their governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council having reviewed the application for WaterSMART Grant Program funding supports its submittal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Council supports this grant request for WaterSMART Program funding and affirms that in accordance with the City Charter and all applicable law the City will do all acts necessary to carry out the purposes of such grant, if awarded.

Section 2: The City Manager of the City of Mesa or designee is hereby authorized to enter appropriate agreements regarding the WaterSMART Grant Program funding on behalf of the City if awarded.

Section 3: That the various City officers and employees be and hereby are authorized and directed to perform all other acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
