### **Informational Update on Recent Council Action:**

At its August 26, 2013 meeting, the City Council acknowledged the receipt of the minutes of the June 18, 2013 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.

At its September 9, 2013 meeting, the City Council introduced an ordinance to

implement the recommendations of the August 20, 2013 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.

**Informational Update on Recent Parking Prohibitions:**

Approved on August 29, 2013 – to address intersection operation concerns and maintain clear driveway access.

- On the south side of Garden Circle (southern leg) from Standage to a point 219 feet east of Standage (new) (north of University Drive and west of Alma School Road, Council District 3).

Approved on August 29, 2013 – to address intersection operation concerns, maintain clear travel lanes and accommodate existing traffic signal.

- On the west side of Standage from the University Drive frontage road to a point 74 feet north of the University Drive frontage road, on the east side of Standage from University Drive to a point 133 feet north of University Drive, and on the north side of the University Drive frontage road from Standage to a point 63 feet west of Standage (new) (west of Alma School Road and north of University Drive, Council District 3).
