REGULATING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE

Benefit to Community

- Review of license application by several City departments to evaluate applicant's compliance with any law or ordinance of the City that may be applicable to the business before the sale of alcoholic beverages within the City occurs.

Meetings with applicable staff and the applicant are held when necessary to resolve any adverse information. Adverse information is provided to the City Council.

REGULATING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE

- Recommendation for approval to the State Department of Liquor Licensing & Control is based on the following criteria to determine whether public convenience requires and that the best interest of the community will be substantially served by the issuance or transfer of a liquor license at a particular unlicensed location (Arizona Administrative Code R19-1-102- Granting a License for a Certain Location):

1. Petitions and testimony from persons in favor of or opposed to the issuance of a license who reside in, own or lease property in close proximity.

2. The number and series of licenses in close proximity.
3. Evidence that all necessary licenses and permits have been obtained from the state and all other governing bodies.
4. The residential and commercial population of the community and its likelihood of increasing, decreasing or remaining static.
5. Residential and commercial population density in close proximity.
6. Evidence concerning the nature of the proposed business, its potential market, and its likely customers.

7. Effect on vehicular traffic in close proximity.
8. The compatibility of the proposed business with other activity in close proximity.
9. The effect or impact of the proposed premises on businesses or the residential neighborhood whose activities might be affected by granting the license.
10. The history for the past five years of liquor violations and reported criminal activity at the proposed premises.

REGULATING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE

11. Comparison of the hours of operation of the proposed premises to the existing businesses in close proximity.
12. Proximity to licensed childcare facilities as defined by A.R.S. § 36-881 ("Child care facility" means any facility in which child care is regularly provided for compensation for five or more children not related to the proprietor).
