

Other Local Municipalities

Mesa's liquor licensing fees have not been revised since 1989 and except for the City of Phoenix, no other local municipalities have revised their fees for at least ten years. Mesa's issuance fee is significantly higher than the other communities, but several of the annual fees are significantly lower. The following table lists the liquor licensing fees charged by other local municipalities for the most commonly issued liquor license series types.
