Board members who have served two consecutive full terms as an officer may be reelected to that office after at least one intervening year on the Board during which he/she does not serve as that officer. Partial terms as an officer shall not be counted towards term limits. The term of Chairperson and Vice Chairperson will begin at the July 2013 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.

**Informational Update on Recent Parking Prohibitions:**

Approved on May 1, 2013 – insufficient roadway width to accommodate travel lanes and on street parking.

- On 82<sup>nd</sup> Street from University Drive to Quarterline Road (new) (west of Hawes Road and north of University Drive, Council District 5).

Approved on May 30, 2013 – to maintain clear travel lanes and address intersection congestion concerns.

- On Kiowa Avenue from a point 145 feet west of Wildrose to a point 145 feet east of Wildrose and on the north side of Kiowa Avenue from a point 60 feet west of Laramie to a point 80 feet east of Laramie (new) (south of Baseline Road and east of Crismon Road, Council District 6).
- On Wildrose from Kiowa Avenue to a point 125 feet north of Kiowa Avenue (new) (east of Crismon Road and south of Baseline Road, Council District 6).
