### 1. Items from citizens present (maximum of three speakers for five minutes per speaker).

Kirby Allan, 2043 East Hackamore, representing the "Brotherhood of Mesa," spoke regarding Mesa's leadership. Mr. Allan noted the importance of the observance and justification of the law. Mr. Allan suggested a reduction in the compensation currently provided to the Mayor and Council.

Krishna Harracksingh, 1711 East First Street, addressed the Council and stated the opinion that inventions are an important element in human life. Mr. Harracksingh said that properties built 40 to 50 years ago were not constructed in accordance with City Codes and as a result owners of the properties are charged excessive energy rates during the Summer months. Mr. Harracksingh explained that by allowing homeowners the ability to place shade screens between the properties, approximately 70 percent of the direct sunlight on the homes would be removed, thereby reducing energy costs.
