

Mesa A-frame Draft Amendment

- Partially Based on Gilbert Ordinance
 - Height – 3', Area – 6 sqft, 20' Spacing
 - Professionally Designed
 - One per business
 - Placement: 3'/Sidewalk, 15'/curb, on -ground
 - No illumination or moving parts
 - Set out in morning, brought back in the evening
 - Violations are subject to confiscation
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
Mesa A-frame Draft Amendment

- Additions to Gilbert Model
 - Requires \$1 million insurance w/ City named as co-insured
 - Requires a Use Permit/fee - "date sticker"
 - Good for 1 year
 - 9-month "Sunset Clause" - trial period
 - Only allowed if no other option for street sign visibility for that business name or use
 - Denies A-frame if C-O-I Development has a Comprehensive Sign Plan
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Need for Parks and Recreational Facilities

From a list of 24 parks and recreational facilities, respondents were asked to indicate which ones they and members of their household have a need for. The following summarizes key findings:

- **Four of the 24 parks and recreational facilities had over 50% of respondent households indicate they have a need for it.** These four facilities include: small neighborhood parks (65%), picnic shelters/area (58%), walking and biking trails (55%), and large community parks (53%).
