




Future Transit System

Gilbert Road Extension

- Two travel lanes on Main Street
 - One in each direction that will widen to four travel lanes at Gilbert Road
- One roundabout
 - Horne
- Two stations
 - Stapley Drive, east of intersection
 - Gilbert Road, west of intersection
- A park-and-ride/transit center
 - Southwest corner of Main Street and Gilbert Road

Construction Timeline

2016-2017 Utility relocation

2017-2018 Road widening

2018 Track and station installations

Early 2019 Light rail testing

Late spring 2019 Begin revenue service



Utility Relocation and Road Widening

- Activities include
 - Utility relocation
 - Demolition of existing roadway, grading and repaving
 - Construction of traffic lanes, curbs, gutter, sidewalks, streetscape and lighting







Track and Station Installations

- Activities include
 - Installation of track
 - Installation of overhead power lines
 - Construction of stations and integration of artwork
 - Construction of park-and-ride facility and traction power substations







Light Rail Testing and Operation

- Activities include
 - Signals and communication
 - Traction power substation testing
 - Overhead contact system testing
 - Safety certification





What to Expect

- Access maintained to businesses and homes
- Notification and coordination of construction activities
- Modification to traffic lanes and sidewalks
- Day and night work
- Scheduled temporary utility interruptions
