### Informational Update on Recent Council Action:

At its January 7, 2016 meeting, the City Council acknowledged the receipt of the minutes of the September 15, 2015 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.

At its January 11, 2016 meeting, the City Council introduced ordinances to implement the recommendations of the September 15, 2015 and December 15, 2015 Transportation Advisory Board meetings.

At its January 25, 2016 meeting, the City Council passed the following ordinances to implement the recommendations of the September 15, 2015 and December 15, 2015 Transportation Advisory Board meetings.

**Ordinance #5306 Traffic-Control Devices: 10-3-13 (E)**

- Add flashing yellow arrows as a traffic control signal legend. (Citywide)

**Ordinance #5307 Speed Limits (45 mph): 10-4-3 and Speed Limits (40 mph): 10-4-4**

- Increase the speed limit from 40 mph to 45 mph on Signal Butte Road from Baseline Road to the Guadalupe Road. (Council District 6)

The ordinances will be effective 30 days after adoption (February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2016).
