- Parks Maintenance Contracts went up about \$600,000 after rebidding the contract.

**Project Update:** Mr. Heirshberg provided an update on the following projects:

- Eagles Community Center Park: The Community Center is currently open.

  Construction for the Park portion of the project has begun with dirt movement to start creating the retention areas and ball fields.
- **Signal Butte and Elliott**: Construction on the basins will begin soon, with Park construction beginning in May.

**Imagine Mesa Update:** Recommendations were given to staff from the Imagine Mesa Committee and staff were tasked with putting together a Capital Improvement List which encompassed those recommendations.
