**POLICE PENSION BOARD**

1. Discuss and consider the Accidental Disability Retirement application of Police Officer Troy Lepird.

Chairman Raines welcomed Police Officer Troy Lepird to the meeting. He explained the situation which lead to this meeting being called. He stated that a letter was sent to Dr. Wilson, indicating that Officer Lepird is not seeking further treatment options, requesting that Dr. Wilson answer all questions listed on the Accidental Disability Questionnaire, and asking clarifying questions to resolve any conflicting statements in the original IME report. He advised Officer Lepird that the response from Dr. Wilson did not resolve any conflicting statements in the original IME report and that the doctor did not answer all of the questions listed on the Accidental Disability Questionnaire.

Discussion ensued regarding Local Board options in this matter.

It was moved by Boardmember Lentz, seconded by Boardmember Brady, that Police Officer Troy Lepird be sent for a second Independent Medical Evaluation.

Chairman Raines declared the motion carried unanimously by those present.
