Kirby Allan, 2043 East Hackamore, representing the organization "Brotherhood of Mesa," provided material to Council and spoke regarding constitutional rights and the initiative process in Arizona. Mr. Allan expressed concern relative to the proposed modification of Proposition 200, a measure approved by voters at the March 1996 Primary Election.

Leland Fairbanks, 1822 East Vineda Lane, Tempe, noted the importance of preventing smoking by youth. Dr. Fairbanks related observations concerning the number of children frequenting local establishments where exemptions to Mesa's smoking ban have been requested.
