Informational Update on Recent Council Action:

At its March 18, 2013 meeting, the City Council introduced an ordinance to implement the recommendations of the February 19, 2013 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.

At its March 28, 2013 meeting, the City Council acknowledged the receipt of the minutes of the February 19, 2013 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.

At its April 1, 2013 meeting, the City Council passed the following ordinance to implement the recommendations of the February 19, 2013 Transportation Advisory Board meeting.

Ordinance #5140 Speed Limits (50 mph): 10-4-2 and Speed Limits (45 mph): 10-4-3

- Increase the speed limit from 45 mph to 50 mph on Ellsworth Road from Elliot Road to the south City limits. (Ellsworth Road south of Elliot Road, Council District 6)

The ordinance will be effective on May 2, 2013.

Informational Update on Recent Parking Prohibitions:

Approved on March 31, 2013 – to allow on street parking as requested by adjacent property owner.

- *(School Days Only 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM)* On Gaylord from Brown Road to Glencove Street (rescind) (west of Lindsay Road and north of Brown Road, Council District 1).
- *(School Days Only 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM)* On the west side of Gaylord from Brown Road to Glencove Street and on the east of Gaylord from Brown Road to a point 118 feet north of Brown Road and on the east of Gaylord from Glencove Street to a point 116 feet south of Glencove Street (new) (west of Lindsay Road and north of Brown Road, Council District 1).

Approved on March 21, 2013 – to improve driveway visibility and allow on street parking and to update an existing parking prohibition in the traffic regulation database to reflect current field conditions.

- On Westwood from 8th Avenue to Elena Circle (rescind) (east of Alma School Road and north of Southern Avenue, Council District 3).
- On the west side of Westwood from a point 110 feet south of 8th Avenue to a point 204 feet south of 8th Avenue, on the west side of Westwood from a point 51 feet north of Elena Circle to a point 149 feet north of Elena Circle, and on the east side of Westwood from a point 290 feet south of 8th Avenue to a point 437 feet south of 8th Avenue (new) (east of Alma School Road and north of Southern Avenue, Council District 3).
