

ORDINANCE NO. 5053

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING "TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL PROGRAM REVISION TO TITLE X OF MESA CITY CODE, JUNE 2011" BY REFERENCE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: ADOPTION BY REFERENCE. That certain document known as "Temporary Traffic Control Program Revision to Title X of Mesa City Code, June 2011" which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 9892 of the City of Mesa, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

Section 2: SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance is held to be unenforceable or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall remain in effect.

Section 3: REPEAL. Mesa City Code Section 10-3-13 (O) and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance or any part of the code adopted by reference in this ordinance are hereby repealed immediately upon this ordinance taking effect. The repeal of Mesa City Code Section 10-3-13 (O) does not affect the rights and duties that matured or penalties that were incurred and proceedings that were begun before the effective date of the repeal.

Section 4: EFFECTIVE DATE. The effective date of this ordinance shall be 30 days following adoption by the Mesa City Council.

Section 5: PENALTIES. Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this Code shall be guilty of a civil violation. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offense punishable as described above.
