

RESOLUTION NO. 10643

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE, TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT AND OTHER RELATED AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE MESA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 4 AND THE CITY OF MESA RELATING TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF FIESTA SPORTS PARK ON A PORTION OF THE MESA EDUCATION CENTER CAMPUS, FORMALLY KNOWN AS POWELL JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement and other related agreements with the Mesa Unified School District No. 4 relating to the development of Fiesta Sports Park on a portion of the Mesa Education Center campus, formerly known as the Powell Junior High School campus on behalf of the City of Mesa, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his designated representative thereon.

Section 2: That the City Manager, or his designated representative, is further authorized to approve and enter into any amendments or modifications to the Intergovernmental Agreement or other related agreements as needed and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his designated representative thereon.
