

RESOLUTION NO. 10648

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MESA AND THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION, COLLECTION, AND/OR LICENSING OF TRANSACTION PRIVILEGE, USE, SEVERANCE, JET FUEL, AND RENTAL OCCUPANCY TAXES IMPOSED BY THE STATE OF ARIZONA AND CITIES OR TOWNS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Mesa and the Arizona Department of Revenue, entitled "Intergovernmental Agreement Between the State of Arizona and the City of Mesa, Arizona" for the administration, collection, audit and/or licensing of transaction privilege tax, use tax, severance tax, jet fuel excise and use taxes, and rental occupancy taxes imposed by the State of Arizona, cities or towns is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City of Mesa, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his designated representative thereon.
