

RESOLUTION NO. 10722

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE, TO ENTER INTO THE FIRST AMEMENMENT TO THE AMENDED AND RESTATED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE TOPAZ REGIONAL WIRELESS COOPERATIVE TO FACILIATE THE ADMISSION OF FORT MCDOWELL YAVAPI NATION AS A MEMBER.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Mesa and the Town of Gilbert, the City of Apache Junction, the Superstition Fire & Medical District, the Town of Queen Creek, and the Rio Verde Fire District is hereby Amended to admit the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation as a member.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to enter into the Amendment, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the person who signs the agreement thereon.
