

RESOLUTION NO. 9805

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, ACTING AS THE LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY WITH RESPECT TO THE AIR FORCE RESEARCH LABORATORY, MESA, ARIZONA.

WHEREAS, the Air Force Research Laboratory, Mesa, Arizona (“AFRL”) was recommended for closure by the 2005 Department of Defense Base Realignment and Closure Commission; and

WHEREAS, the AFRL was declared surplus on June 14, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Mesa requested that the Council become and be designated as the local redevelopment authority (“LRA”) for the reuse of AFRL; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2010, the Council was recognized by the Department of Defense Office of Economic Adjustment as the organization responsible for preparation of a redevelopment plan for AFRL, including outreach to homeless providers and other interested parties; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 32 CFR Part 176, the LRA is required to submit a redevelopment plan and a homeless assistance submission to the Air Force and the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 32 CFR Part 176, the LRA conducted outreach and screening of the AFRL to determine potential uses by homeless providers and public benefit users and caused a draft redevelopment plan and homeless assistance submission to be prepared; and

WHEREAS, the LRA sought public comments on such redevelopment plan and homeless assistance submission; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Mesa, acting as the LRA, hereby wishes to approve such redevelopment plan and homeless assistance submission;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, ACTING AS THE LRA FOR AFRL, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Council of the City of Mesa, acting as the LRA for AFRL, hereby approves the redevelopment plan and homeless assistance submission submitted by LRA staff.

Section 2: That the Council of the City of Mesa requests that the LRA staff submit the redevelopment plan and homeless assistance submission to the Air Force and the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Section 3: That in the event that the LRA staff identify necessary changes based on consultations with the Air Force and Department of Housing and Urban Development which are not substantive or material and which do not address additional facts not previously considered, the LRA staff shall be authorized to make such changes.
