1. Call to Order.

Co-Chairperson Benelli called the meeting to order.

Principal Planner Tom Ellsworth explained that the Co-Chairs assigned Committeemembers to the four sub-committees, notified them via email, and provided an agenda, sample evaluation worksheet, and an updated Imagine Mesa ideas list.

Mr. Ellsworth confirmed that the Google drive has been setup and noted that all members need a gmail account in order to have access and that the evaluation worksheet and Imagine Mesa idea lists will be placed on the Google drive.

Mr. Ellsworth stated that staff has assigned each sub-committee a staff liaison and facilitator to assist with questions and to keep the sub-committee on task.

Mr. Ellsworth explained the evaluation worksheet, which is to assist in determining the success factors for the Imagine Mesa ideas and the high-low impact and high-low effort matrix (**See Attachment 1**). He displayed the Imagine Mesa ideas lists (**See Attachment 2**) for each sub-committee and pointed out that the green highlights indicate new Imagine Mesa ideas that were added since the last Imagine Mesa Advisory Committee meeting and pointed out that the Google drive will have the most recent Imagine Mesa idea lists.

Mr. Ellsworth stated that Imagine Mesa will conduct an outreach at three events in October:

- Celebrate Mesa
- Mesa Latino Town Hall
- Dia de los Muertos Festival

In response to a question posed by Committeemember Kee, Mr. Ellsworth reported that staff placed the Imagine Mesa ideas into the four groups and that if any of the sub-committees decides that an idea should be moved to another sub-committee to let him know and he will adjust as needed.

Mr. Ellsworth reviewed the process which includes, identifying the Imagine Mesa ideas, determine success criteria using the evaluation worksheet and matrix, and the final step is a recommendation to Council.

In response to a question posed by Co-Chairperson Benelli, Mr. Ellsworth stated that the notes section on the evaluation worksheet would indicate if the sub-committee would like a presentation by staff, or information from the original submitter, and to notify the staff liaison.

In response to a question from Committeemember Kee, Mr. Ellsworth confirmed that staff can reach the original Imagine Mesa idea submitter and that presentations will be limited to ten minutes.

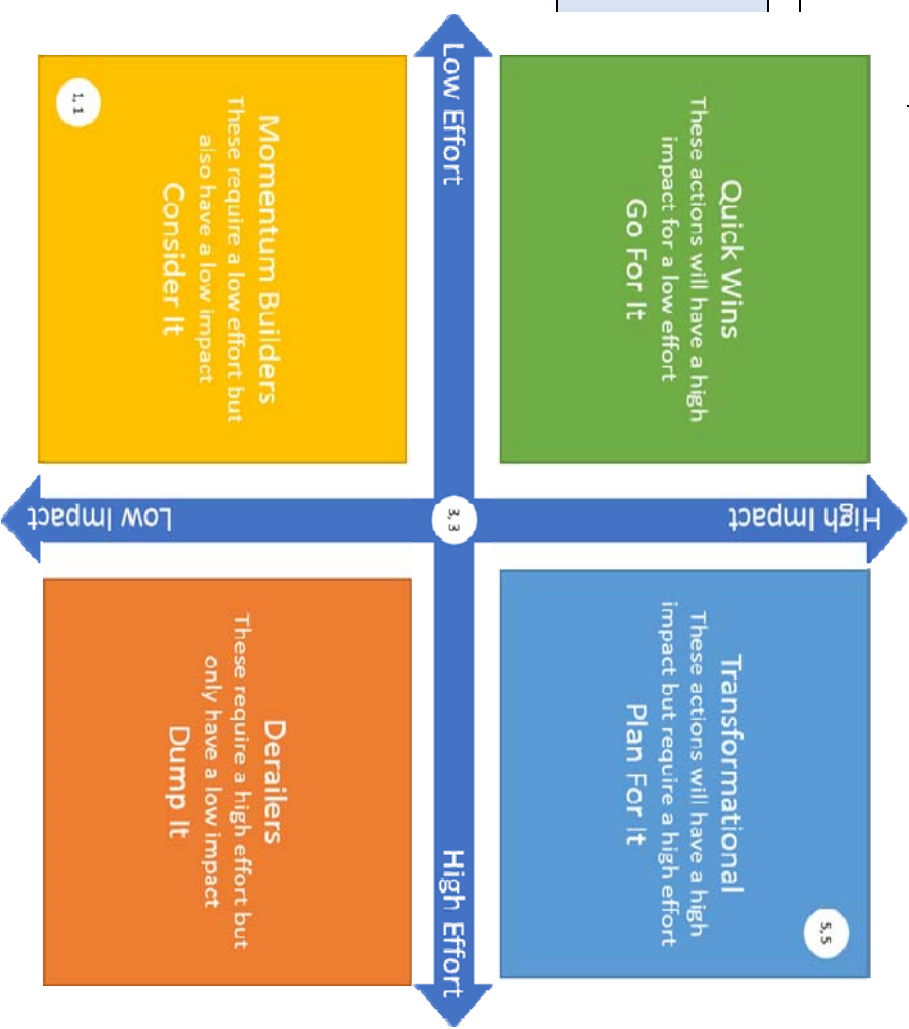
