Emergency Rehabilitation Program

The Emergency Rehabilitation Program provides federal assistance through a grant offered through Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to address household repairs that affect the immediate livability of the home.



Emergency Based Assistance



\$25,000 Maximum/year



Limited Repairs



Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, homeowners must meet certain criteria, including, but not limited to:

QUALIFYING EMERGENCY REPAIR

OWN AND LIVE IN HOME 12 MONTHS

CAN NOT OPERATE A HOME-BASED BUSINESS

CAN NOT BE A RENTAL PROPERTY

CURRENT PROPERTY TAXES & UTILITIES

INCOME ELIGIBLE PER HUD GUIDELINES



Income Limits

As of June 15, 2023, the below chart demonstrates the HUD maximum gross household income based on family size to be income-eligible:

Eligible Repairs

Emergency Repairs are limited to those issues that affect the habitability of the home, including but not limited to:



Resident Spotlight






